Applications are invited from suitably qualified Zambian nationals to contest for five (05) Vocational Training scholarships at diploma level offered by the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria for the 2024/2025 academic year. The scholarships are offered in the fields of Maintenance of Agricultural Machinery, Animal Production - Breeding of Small Animals, Sanitary, Air Condition and Heater Installation, Industrial Welding, Mechanical Production - Electro Technical, IT - Databases, Maintenance of Industrial Vehicles, Tourism - Production and Marketing, Installation and Maintenance of Irrigation Equipment, Site Surveyor, Plant Protection, Building Site Instructor, Public Works Instructor, Housing Rehabilitation and Renovation, Management & Recycling, and Quality Control in the Food Industry.

These vocational training programs aim to enhance the employability and entrepreneurial skills of students. The host institutions collaborate with various stakeholders to provide practical, hands-on training in different vocational disciplines, focusing on equipping students with the necessary skills to succeed in the job market and to start their own businesses.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants should:

- Be a Zambian citizen with a Green National Registration Card (NRC)
- Have a Birth Certificate
- Have a Zambian Passport valid for at least One (1) year
- Have a full Grade 12 certificate with Grades 1 6
- Not older than 25 years old by 1st September, 2024

- (ii) Any short fall not adequately covered by the scholarship.
