Applications are invited from suitably qualified Zambian Nationals that meet the *minimum* requirements outlined here below to contest for fifteen (15) scholarships under the Mauritius Africa Scholarships Scheme for the 2025/2026 Academic Year. Available are: Two (02) PhD, Three (03) Masters, and ten (10) Undergraduates in the following fields of study: Computer Science with Network Security, Software Engineering, Web Technologies, Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Civil Engineering, Tourism and Hospitality Management, Accounting with Finance and Marketing.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants should:

•Be Zambian citizens with Green National Registration Cards (NRC)

Undergraduate Applicants:

- Be School Leavers who completed Grade 12 from **2019 to 2023.**
- •Must have A-levels with Grade A+, A and B+ in English, Mathematics and subjects relevant to the intended field of study
- Be of minimum age 18 and maximum of 26 years by 01 January 2026.

Master's Applicants

- Hold relevant Bachelor's degree with at least an upper second class or (CPA/GPA) greater than 60% • Be of maximum age 40 years by 01 January, 2026
- Must have full Grade 12 certificate/results

PhD Applicants

- Hold relevant Bachelor's degree with at least an upper second class or (CPA/GPA) greater than 60%
- Hold relevant Master's degree in a related field of study Be of maximum age 40 years by 01 January, 2026
- Must have full Grade 12 certificate/results

CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP a Candidates should meet own cost towards:

- (i) Expenses to and from the Airport;
 - (ii) Any costs not covered by the scholarship
- b The scholarship will cover the following:

(i) Return Air fare from Zambia to Mauritius at the end of studies

- (ii) Tuition fees and stipend (living allowance) during studies in Mauritius

ELIGIBILITY

- A study plan or synopsis of summarized details of the preferred course and how the intended course of study will enhance one's contribution to the Zambia's development (200 words for Undergraduate applicants, 1500 words for Masters and PhD applicants)
- •Employer's recommendation letter stating that the applicant would be granted leave to take up offer if selected (only for Masters and PhD applicants).
