



MAURITIUS AFRICA SCHOLARSHIPS

Applications are invited from suitably qualified Zambian Nationals that meet the **minimum** requirements outlined here below to contest for **fifteen (15) scholarships** under the Mauritius Africa Scholarships Scheme for the **2025/2026** Academic Year. Available are: **Two (02) PhD, Three (03) Masters**, and **ten (10) Undergraduates** in the following fields of study: **Computer Science with Network Security, Software Engineering, Web Technologies, Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Civil Engineering, Tourism and Hospitality Management, Accounting with Finance and Marketing.**

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants should:

- Be Zambian citizens with Green National Registration Cards (NRC)

Undergraduate Applicants:

- Be School Leavers who completed Grade 12 from **2019 to 2023**.
- Must have A-levels with Grade A+, A and B+ in English, Mathematics and subjects relevant to the intended field of study
- Be of minimum age 18 and maximum of 26 years by 01 January 2026.

Master's Applicants

- Hold relevant Bachelor's degree with at least an upper second class or (CPA/GPA) greater than 60%
- Be of maximum age 40 years by 01 January, 2026
- Must have full Grade 12 certificate/results

PhD Applicants

- Hold relevant Bachelor's degree with at least an upper second class or (CPA/GPA) greater than 60%
- Hold relevant Master's degree in a related field of study
- Be of maximum age 40 years by 01 January, 2026
- Must have full Grade 12 certificate/results

CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

a Candidates should meet own cost towards:

- (i) Expenses to and from the Airport;
- (ii) Any costs not covered by the scholarship

b The scholarship will cover the following:

- (i) Return Air fare from Zambia to Mauritius at the end of studies
- (ii) Tuition fees and stipend (living allowance) during studies in Mauritius

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants should submit:

- Candidates must download documents available on the following website on the guidelines regarding the conditions attached to the scholarship, the application procedure, and a list of public Higher Education Institutions in Mauritius where full time on campus studies are run.

- Candidates are strongly advised to apply directly to their preferred institutions in advance of their scholarship application on the websites provided above.
- Masters and PhD candidates are advised to apply in the field relevant/equivalent to their previous qualification.

DURATION

This is dependent on the programme to be pursued, however, Undergraduates programmes are 4years, Masters programmes are 2 years and PhD programmes are 4years.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

Applicants should submit:

- Typed application letter responding to the advert, clearly stating the field of study desired, age and mobile phone number for easy communication
- Curriculum Vitae,
- Certified Copies of Educational Certificates: (Grade 12 Results/Certificates and A-levels Results certified by ECZ), Certified copies of certificates and transcripts of Bachelor's and Master's degrees for Masters and PhD applicants
- Two (02) Passport size photos and **colour photocopy of pages 2 and 3 of applicants passport**
- A study plan or synopsis of summarized details of the preferred course and how the intended course of study will enhance one's contribution to the Zambia's development (**200** words for Undergraduate applicants, **1500** words for Masters and PhD applicants)
- Employer's recommendation letter stating that the applicant would be granted leave to take up offer if selected (only for Masters and PhD applicants).

It is a requirement by the host country that all nominated candidates undergo comprehensive medical examinations including the **HIV test, TB and Hepatitis A and B**.

Nominated candidates must note that **last-minute withdrawals will attract serious sanctions from the Loans Board which may include being blacklisted**.
