ELIGIBILITY:

To apply for these scholarships, you must:

(a) Be a Zambian Citizen with a Green National Registration Card.

(b) Preferably applicants should be researchers or instructors (Zambian lecturers from local universities) who needs to obtain M.Sc. or Ph.D. degree in the fields of Science or Engineering.

(c) Be permanent resident in Zambia.

(d) Be available to start your studies in the Japan-Egypt by the start of the E-JUST academic year in September 2025.

(e) Be applicants unable afford to study in Japan-Egypt without a scholarship.

(f) Applicant should hold a first degree of atleast upper second class (2:1) honours standard or a second class degree (Minimum Merit) for Masters.

(g) Applicants should hold a Master's degree to apply for a PhD program.

- All candidates must demonstrate in their application the direct and applied relevance of their study to development in their home country. Candidates should make any such links explicit in their applications.

- Applicants must be of 34 years (Masters) and 39 years (PhD).

- **A typed application letter** responding to the advertisement, clearly stating the field of study desired and phone number for easy communication.

- **Curriculum Vitae, photocopies** of Education certificates, transcripts and National Registration Card (NRC).

- **A typed study plan/synopsis** of the preferred course demonstratinthe direct and applied relevance of the intended course of study to one's contribution to Zambia's development **(400 words)**.

- **Recommendation letters** from their respective employers indicating that they would be granted leave to take up offers if selected.

- Application fee of **K100** should be deposited at any NATSAVE Branch.

- Printed online application form
