• **Benefits:** Covers tuition fees up to MUR 100,000, a monthly living allowance of MUR 16,500, free basic health care in public hospitals, and a return airfare to and from Mauritius.


• The scholarship will also provide a pathway for students that successfully complete the **Diploma** programme to transition into a **Bachelor's** Degree Programme.

• **Application Process:** Applicants must have applied for at least one full-time on-campus program at a public higher education institution in Mauritius and submit proof of application with the scholarship request.
