Available scholarships are in the following fields of study: Computer Science, Mechanical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Architecture, Electrical and Electronic Engineering, General Medicine, Economics and Pharmacy.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants should:

- Be a Zambian citizen with a Green National Registration Card (NRC)
- Have a Birth Certificate
- Have a Zambian Passport valid for at least One (1) year
- Be School Leavers who completed Grade 12 in 2021, 2022 and 2023
- Have **Grades 1-3** in English, Mathematics and subjects relevant to the intended field of
- Have **Pure Sciences** if applying for **General Medicine** and **all Engineering programmes**
- Must not be older than 19 years of age by December, 2024.

CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

Candidates should meet own cost towards:

- (i) Expenses to and from the Airport;
- (ii) Any short fall not adequately covered by the scholarship.

Study period ranges from four (04) years to six (06) depending on the programme to be pursued.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

Applicants should submit:

DURATION

- A typed application letter responding to the advert, clearly stating the field of study desired, age and mobile phone number for easy communication;
- Curriculum Vitae, Certified Photocopies of Educational Certificates, Transcript/Statement of results certified by ECZ, Certified NRC, certified photocopy of applicant's birth certificate, two (2) colour passport size photos and colour photocopy of pages 2 and 3 of applicant's passport;
- A study plan or synopsis of summarized details of the preferred course and how the intended course of study will enhance one's contribution to Zambia's development (200 words for undergraduates)
