



MOROCCAN MASTERS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Applications are invited from suitably qualified Zambian nationals to contest for one (01) scholarship at master's level offered by the Moroccan Agency for International Cooperation (AMCI) for the 2025/2026 academic year. The scholarship programme being offered is in the field of water and sustainable Horticulture. It is a two-year programme taught in English.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants should:

- Be Zambian citizens with Green National Registration Cards (NRC)
- Have a Birth Certificate
- Have a Zambian Passport valid for at least One (1) year
- Have a Grade 12 full certificate
- Certified copies of university transcripts
- Not be older than 35 years old by 1st September, 2025
- **Applicants must hold bachelor's degree in engineering or equivalent in the following fields; Agriculture, agronomy, economics, animal husbandry or Sociology.**

CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

Candidates should meet own cost towards:

- (i) Expenses to and from the Airport;
- (ii) Any short fall not adequately covered by the scholarship.

DURATION

The program is for Two years taught in English.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

Applicants should submit:

- A **typed** application letter responding to the advert, clearly stating the field of study desired, age, mobile phone number and email address for easy communication;
- Curriculum Vitae, Certified Photocopies of Educational Certificates, Transcript/Statement of results certified by Examinations Council of Zambia, National Registration Card, certified photocopy of applicant's birth certificate, two (2) **colour passport size photos bearing the applicant's name at the back and colour photocopy of pages 2 and 3 of applicant's passport** and Police Clearance Certificate;
- A motivation essay of the course stating personal expectations and interests and how the course of study will enhance one's contribution to Zambia's development **(500 words)**.

A clear copy of deposit slip from NATSAVE of **K100** application fee **(application fee should be deposited at any NATSAVE branch)**.

NOTE: No cash payments will be accepted at HELSB Offices.

It is a requirement by the host country that all nominated candidates undergo comprehensive medical examinations including the **HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis A and B, Tuberculosis (TB) and pregnancy tests for females.**

Nominated candidates must note that **last-minute withdraw will attract serious sanctions from HELSB which may include being blacklisted.**
