Available are undergraduate programmes in the following fields of study with its quota allocations; General Medicine - (03), PharmD - (01), Anastesia and Reanimation - (04), Pharmacy - (01), Architecture - (01), Agronomy - (03), Electrical Engineering - (14), Mechanical Engineering -(08), Civil Engineering - (08), Economics - (10), Chemical Engineering and Biomedical Sciences - (08), Computer Science and Software Engineering -(08), Commerce and Business Management - (12), Life and Earth Sciences -(05), Chemistry Environmental and Biological Sciences (04), Radiology (03), Anesthesia (02), Mechanical Sciences (05).

### **ELIGIBILITY**

#### Applicants should:

- Be a Zambia citizen with a Green National Registration Card (NRC)
- Have a Birth Certificate
- Have a Zambian Passport valid for at least One (1) year
- Be school leavers who completed Grade 12 in 2024;
- Have **Grades 1-3** in English, Mathematics and subjects relevant to the intended field of study;
- Have Pure Sciences if applying for General Medicine and all Engineering programmes;
- Be between 19 and 23 years by September 2025.

## **CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

## **Candidates should meet own cost towards:**

- (i) Expenses to and from the Airport;
- (ii) Any short fall not adequately covered by the scholarship.

# **DURATION**
