Applications are invited from suitably qualified Zambian nationals that meet the **minimum** requirements outlined here below to contest for **One Hundred (100)** scholarships under the Moroccan Government Scholarship Scheme for the **2025/2026** Academic Year. Available are **undergraduate programmes** in the following fields of study with its quota allocations; **General Medicine - (03), PharmD - (01), Anastesia and Reanimation - (04), Pharmacy - (01), Architecture - (01), Agronomy - (03), Electrical Engineering - (14), Mechanical Engineering - (08), Civil Engineering - (08), Economics - (10), Chemical Engineering and Biomedical Sciences - (08), Computer Science and Software Engineering - (08), Commerce and Business Management - (12), Life and Earth Sciences - (05), Chemistry Environmental and Biological Sciences (04), Radiology (03), Anesthesia (02), Mechanical Sciences (05).**

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants should:

- Be a Zambia citizen with a Green National Registration Card (NRC)
- Have a Birth Certificate
- Have a Zambian Passport valid for at least One (1) year
- Be school leavers who completed Grade 12 in **2024;**
- Have **Grades 1-3** in English, Mathematics and subjects relevant to the intended field of study;
- Have Pure Sciences if applying for General Medicine and all Engineering programmes; and
- Be between 19 and 23 years by September 2025.

CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

Candidates should meet own cost towards:

- (i) Expenses to and from the Airport;
- (ii) Any short fall not adequately covered by the scholarship.

DURATION

This is dependent on the programme to be pursued, however, all programmes include One (1) year of French language (5 to 8 years).

METHOD OF APPLICATION

Applicants should submit:

- A **typed** application letter responding to the advertisement, clearly stating the field of study desired, age and mobile phone number for easy communication;
- Curriculum Vitae, copies of Statement of Results, NRC, certified copy of applicant's birth certificate, Two (2) colour passport size photos and **colour photocopy of pages 2 and 3 of applicant's passport;**
- A study plan or synopsis of summarized details of the preferred course and how the intended course of study will enhance one's contribution to Zambia's development **(200 words);**
- A clear copy of the deposit slip for application fee from NATSAVE.

It is a requirement by the host country that all nominated candidates undergo comprehensive medical examinations including the **HIV test, Tuberculosis (TB) test, Hepatitis B tests and Covid-19 certificate.**

Nominated candidates must note that **last-minute withdraw will attract serious sanctions from HELSB which may include being blacklisted.**

A clear copy of the deposit slip from NATSAVE of **K100** application fee **(Application Fee should be deposited at any NATSAVE branch)**
